What is Do Not Track

Do not track is a setting from your browser which, after you enable it, it will tell the sites that you visit that you do not want to be tracked. Unfortunately, it is not very well supported by browsers as of yet but if we receive this header setting from your browser and we honor it.

Ignoring DNT on Lawless Analytics

What if you want to track everyone and skip the DNT setting? It is possible to do that as well if you are a website owner.

To ignore the DNT and to also track those visitors, simply add `data-ignore-dnt="true"` like in the following example:
